SUBJECT: Approval of Contract with Rehak General Engineering for the

Cachagua Multi-Sport Field

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff respectfully recommends that the Board approve a contract (**ATTACHMENT 1**) with Rehak General Engineering for the Cachagua Multi-Sport Field improvements.

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$71,200 labor

\$12,000 to \$15,000 for additive alternate Class II baserock

FUNDING SOURCE:

6975 – Cachagua Community Center/Park

FUNDING BALANCE:

\$130,724 as of the writing of this report.

DISCUSSION:

On April 10, 2019, the Board authorized issuance of a Request for Bids (RFB) for the completion of the Cachagua Community Park Multi-Sport Field. Staff advertised the project in the Monterey County Herald, on the District website, and at the Central Coast Builder's Association.

Staff required a mandatory pre-bid on-site walk through to qualify for bidding on this project. Bids were opened at the District on Thursday, April 25. Only two bids were received, one from Monterey Peninsula Engineering out of Marina, and the other from Thomas J. Rehak, doing business as Rehak General Engineering out of Auberry, California.

Rehak General Engineering was the lower of the two bids at \$71,200. Monterey Peninsula Engineering's bid was \$128,500. Bidder's were requested to provide a material's cost for an additive alternate to provide additional baserock for the project. It is anticipated that more base rock will be required to achieve the 4-inch base than Friend's of Cachagua Children's Center will be able to donate.

BFS Landscape Architects will provide construction management for the grading and fencing project.

Staff recommends that the Board approve a contract (**ATTACHMENT 1**) with Rehak General Engineering for the completion of the Cachagua Community Park Multi-Sport Field.
