SUBJECT: Administration Division Staff Report: Update

REPORT: **Cachagua Sports Fields Reconstruction Project:** In the absence of a Planning and Conservation Division Manager, the Administration Division has taken the role of project manager. Reconstruction of the multi-use sports fields has been completed. The facility will provide the community and its visitors opportunities to play softball, Little League baseball and youth soccer (**ATTACHMENT 1**).

MPPRPD worked closely with the community and the Esselen Tribe to plan this project and ensure its compliance with state and federal statutes. A soft opening is expected in August. A dedication ceremony will be planned for this Fall.

Steelhead Trout Released at Cachagua: The Monterey Peninsula Regional Water Management District, in consort with MPPRPD's conservation, restoration and reintroduction efforts, recently gathered numerous steelhead hatchlings from a tributary that is subject to seasonal drying. The hatchlings were promptly released into the Carmel River, downstream of the park's Stone House (**ATTACHMENT 2**).

Business Excellence Award: On the 25th of July, the Monterey Peninsula Chamber of Commerce awarded MPPRPD this year's EXCELLENCE AWARD for the Government, Utilities, and Transportation category (**ATTACHMENT 3**).

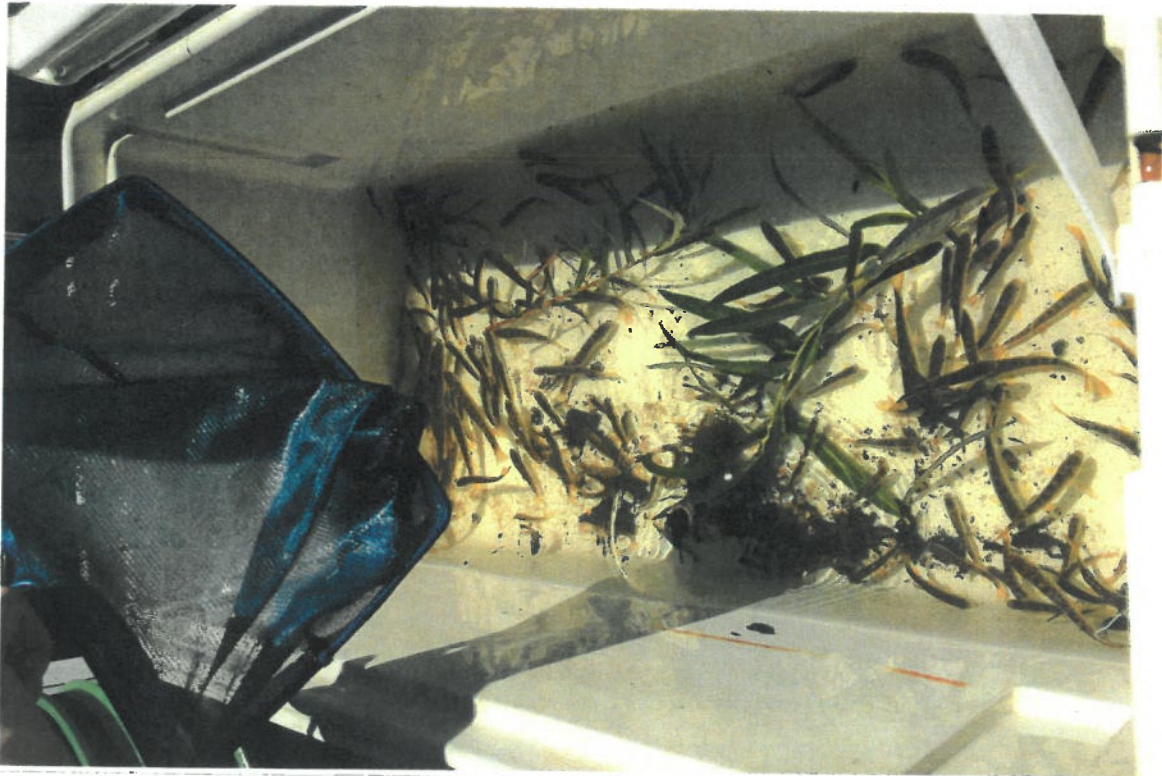
