SUBJECT: Palo Corona Regional Park Story Map: An Online Application

of the Lands History, Mr. Brandt Bates, Turf Image

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Staff requests the Board receive the presentation. The presentation introduces the online story map of Palo Corona Regional Park and its applications (**ATTACHMENT 1**) and its progress to date, and the application is scheduled to be launched proposed Winter 2018.

FISCAL IMPACT:

For the research, design, launch and maintenance of the app, \$1,000 has been allocated.

FUNDING SOURCE:

Funding for GIS and mapping services come from Professional Services accounts in Planning and Conservation, #6549 in the amount of \$47,000, and Environmental Education and Community Outreach, #6349 in the amount of \$4,800.

FUNDING BALANCE:

As of September 1, the balance in account #6549 was \$125,000 and account #6349 was \$7,750.

DISCUSSION:

MPRPD staff has been working with Turf Image to create user- and web-friendly maps and educational outreach applications for Palo Corona Regional Park. The applications will effectively engage and reach diverse audiences, providing a venue to build greater connections to the landscape through history; as identified in the MPRPD Strategic Plan 2016-2020 - goal 2 and goal 3. It is a tool to use in the planning of opening the backcountry of Palo Corona Regional Park, and pilots a product to be used at other MPRPD parks.

Tonight's presentation offers an overview of the historical research, mapping criteria and processes that were taken in preparation to launch the application.
