SUBJECT: Second Public Hearing to Review and Approve Draft Redistricting Maps

SUMMARY:

The District’s consultants at Redistricting Insights will present revised draft maps for Board consideration, so that the second and final public hearing can be held to discuss draft documents.

DISCUSSION:

After the census is taken every ten years by the federal government, public agencies are required to redraw district maps based on revised population data—a process known as “redistricting”. With the assistance of our consultant, Redistricting Insights, and based on new data, the Board held an initial public hearing on March 2, 2022 to review initial draft maps. Based on Board and public input on the initial drafts, the consultant has prepared revised draft hard copy (**ATTACHMENT 1**) and interactive (**ATTACHMENT 2**) maps for Board and public review and consideration. Note: the maps attached are the ones presented at the last Board meeting, except for the “Draft Four – Adjusted” maps at the end of the attachment, which reflect guidance from the Board at the last meeting.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

It is recommended that the Board review and discuss proposed options and provide feedback, then open the public hearing to solicit public input on draft documents. After closing the public hearing, staff requests that the Board approve final maps.
