A project summary listing the preferred alternatives (ATTACHMENT 1), and the proposed GDP and Appendix are attached (ATTACHMENTS 2 and 3).

DISCUSSION:

In 2015, the District commissioned **DESIGN**WORKSHOP to develop a General Development Plan (GDP) for Palo Corona Regional Park. Several focus groups were convened, and public planning sessions were held, allowing the public to actively participate in the park's visioning, planning, programming and proposed development.

The District's potential acquisition of the former Rancho Canada Golf Club (Rancho Canada Unit) was announced in 2016. **DESIGN**WORKSHOP and the District determined it was prudent to slow the GDP's development to ensure that the Rancho Canada Unit was represented in the plan. In April 2018, The Trust for Public Land conveyed a substantial portion of the former golf course to the District.
