RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff respectfully recommends approval of an additional one-year Agreement for Professional Services (ATTACHMENT 1) authorizing an Agreement for Legal Services to be provided by the firm of Lozano Smith Attorney's at Law to the Monterey Peninsula Regional Park District in substantially the form submitted.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Hourly costs on an as-needed basis as set forth in Exhibit C of the attached draft agreement (ATTACHMENT 1).

Staff anticipates a status quo in cost compared to the FY2017-18 budget, but will monitor closely to minimize fiscal impact. Increased costs should they be realized, shall be absorbed within the respective Board approved FY2018-19 budget. As of this report the District expended a total of \$1,527 during FY2017-18.

DISCUSSION:

The District has been utilizing the services of Lozano Smith Attorney's at Law since the Board approved the as needed hourly services on June 1, 2015.

Costs for the services of Lozano Smith Attorneys at Law on a fiscal year basis are:

FY 2015-16; \$12,361.28 FY 2016-17; \$21,158.99 FY 2017-18; \$1,526.85

The term of the current agreement expired June 30, 2018 (ATTACHMENT 2).

A provision within the terms of the agreement allows for additional one-year terms upon written mutual agreement. Since the original one-year agreement and the renewed

agreements exceed \$25,000, staff is seeking Board approval for an additional one- year agreement. Included in this report is a draft agreement (ATTACHMENT 1) staff is recommending the Board approve the agreement retroactive to July 1, 2018.
