REPORT:	<b>Education</b> Twenty-five California State University Monterey Bay Environmental Interpretation and Outreach (ENSTU 349S) students were led on an interpretive methods and exhibit design process tour of the Palo Corona Regional Park (PCRP) Discovery Center.
	The United Way of Monterey County staff retreat was held at the PCRP. Staff participated in an educational exhibit-based scavenger hunt in the Discovery Center and interpretive walk along the trails.
